





Application for designation of St James Ward as a neighbourhood area

NOTICE IS GIVEN that Exeter City Council has received from the Exeter St James Forum an application under Regulation 5 of the above Regulations for the Council to designate the area comprising the St James electoral ward as a neighbourhood area within the meaning of Section 61G of the 1990 Act (see explanatory notes below).
