

WHAT WE WANT TO HEAR FROM THE NEW MAYOR OF LONDON

PARKS and GREEN SPACES in London

THERE WILL BE NO BUILDING ON GREEN BELT AND METROPOLITAN OPEN LAND ON MY WATCH.

I will call an immediate halt to the current sacrifice of playing fields and recreation grounds for development.

I WILL create PARKS FOR LONDON (Pfl) to secure funding for the future of London's parks and green spaces, and coordinate public, private and voluntary sector action.

I will not let London's parks and green spaces decline through lack of funding and I will ensure the standard of parks meets community expectations.

I WILL take action to reduce the traffic noise and air pollution in 10 of London's worst affected parks and green spaces.

I WILL create up to 5 new parks and commons for London.

I will give communities new green assets from under-used, wasted and neglected green spaces.

I WILL transform the green and open spaces around 10 social housing estates every year for four years.

I will be inspired by the Neighbourhoods Green initiative that has already seen unloved space turned into wildlife, food growing, and secure and fun play spaces that contribute to regeneration of an area for everyone.

I WILL establish a London Metropolitan Parks Festival, to promote and regenerate one of London's major metropolitan parks every 4 years.

I will create a year-long festival of cultural and sporting events to celebrate the benefits of green assets to the community and bring in funds to improve the fabric of our parks.
